Teachers Training and Assessment Firm – The Contract price is: PKR 150,469,875 (Rupees One hundred and fifty million, Four hundred and sixty-nine thousand, Eight hundred and Seventy-Five only) and US\$ 891,963 (US dollars Eight hundred and ninety-one thousand, nine hundred and sixty-three only) inclusive of all local direct tax (advance income tax applicable at the date of signing the Contract) and indirect taxes (SST and stamp duty on contracts applicable at the date of signing the Contract). The local indirect taxes chargeable in respect of this Contract for the Services provided by the Consultant shall "be paid" by the Client "for" the Consultant.

The time period of the phase is 36 months with following scope;

- (i) The Teacher Training and Assessment Firm (TTAF) will be responsible for supporting the EA and PIU to achieve the project's activities (2.2, 2.3, 2.4 and 2.7 under Output 2) and activities (3.1, 3.2 and 3.5 under Output 3) given under Table 3: Overall Project Implementation Plan of the Project Administration Manual (PAM);
- (ii) Undertake a survey of selected SELD and SEF secondary schools to identify the capacity and training needs of secondary school teachers in 5 key subjects: English, mathematics, biology, chemistry and physics;
- (iii) Review the existing secondary education teacher training curriculum and prepare/revise training modules for training and mentoring secondary teachers in five key subjects English, mathematics, biology, chemistry and physics;
- (iv) Provide classroom training and in-class mentoring of secondary education teachers by subject specialist master trainers for the five key subjects;
- (v) Develop baseline and endline surveys for measuring teacher capacity;
- (vi) Build the capacity of selected Sindh teacher training institutes and the Sindh PITE in five key subjects English, mathematics, biology, chemistry and physics;
- (vii) Support in development of a uniform examination syllabus and specifications for grades 9–12 for BISE in Sindh;
- (viii) Support the redesign of the content of board examinations for grades 9-12 to increase their emphasis on critical thinking;
